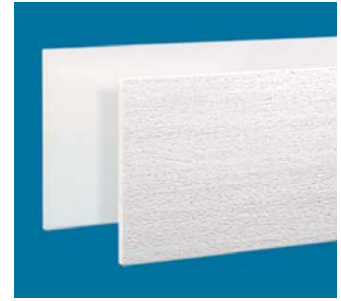

It's easy to custom finish, and although it never needs painting—the option is certainly yours. Use 100% acrylic latex for light colors and Sherwin-Williams® VinylSafe™ paint for dark colors*. Whether you choose Smooth or TrueTexture woodgrain, it complements vinyl, wood, stucco, fiber cement and brick siding. Since you can use Restoration Millwork wherever you would use wood, it's ideal for single- and multi-family housing, light commercial developments and remodeling projects.

* Sherwin-Williams VinylSafe Technology colors must be used when choosing darker colors that have a Light Reflecting Value (LRV) of 54 or lower. For colors with a LRV of 55 or higher (the higher the LRV, the lighter the color), you can safely use an acrylic latex paint.

Because Restoration Millwork has a tight cell structure, cut edges are very close to factory finish. High-performance features make Restoration Millwork the right choice for any non-weight-bearing exterior trim application, and it can even be heat-formed for radius applications such as arched windows and doorways.
